The Regional Plan for Sustainable Development will be the first regionally- Team Members adopted, consensus-based sustainability plan for the Gulf Coast Planning Region of Texas. The plan will address the interaction of land use, transportation and infrastructure, housing, economic development, and environmental elements – and the social equity issues related to each – and contain appropriate implementation strategies identifying context-specific strategies for the region's urban, suburban, rural and coastal communities.

As a sub-consultant to AECOM, Knudson assisted in preparing the Public Engagement Action Plan (PEAP) and the Community Asset Database. The PEAP specified the details of outreach activities to be used during the public engagement process.
