The Julia C. Hester House project in Houston's Fifth Ward consisted of a three phase development process to revitalize the facilities in order to support an Urban Revival Program in Harris County Precinct One. The intent of the developers was for Hester House to evolve into a center for community activities such as concerts, art exhibits, free classes, family activities, community meetings, and a neighborhood pool to be used for instructional swim.
