



MUD #23 – Parks Masterplan



Project Description

Fort Bend, Municipal Utility District No. 23 is a 1,300 acre community located near Fresno, TX. In 2005, Knudson assisted the Board of MUD 23 in creating a comprehensive Parks and Open Space Master Plan for the entire District.

The Master Plan identified the existing and future recreational needs of the District and met all the requirements of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. The Master Plan identified pedestrian circulation and the creation of amenity centers as its top priorities. Knudson also assisted the District with public outreach by conducting resident surveys, gathering stake holder input, and holding several public meetings to discuss the plan. In May of 2006, the voters of District, overwhelming approved an \$8 million dollar authorization for Park improvement expenditures.
